ICD Spring / Summer 2025 Class Enrollment

Eligibility and Enrollment Priorities:

Tuition Vouchers: Available exclusively to hourly employees.

Class Attendance: Retirees, spouses, and salaried employees may attend classes if the instructor is not compensated on a per-student basis (e.g., HVAC, 3D Printing, Online classes) and only if space permits.

Priority: Hourly employees are given precedence over retirees, spouses, and salaried employees for class spots.

This rule also applies to Auto Repair, Motorcycle Repair, and Small Engine Repair. If an active shows up, they have priority before Retiree or Salary.
NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Class Participation Guidelines:

The Institute for Career Development (ICD) is a benefit under the Basic Labor Agreement to provide non-work-related training. However, most members use ICD to help save money by learning to make their own auto and home repairs, solve computer problems, or pursue personal interests.

ICD Cleveland offers a range of customized classes that include a variety of hands-on classes including small engine, gardening, auto repair, woodworking, and motorcycle repair. We also offer pre-craft courses (MTM & MTE prep) and HVAC. There are classes to help members stay in shape including Yoga and Core Conditioning. Computer, photography, artistic glass, and a variety of music classes round out the selections.

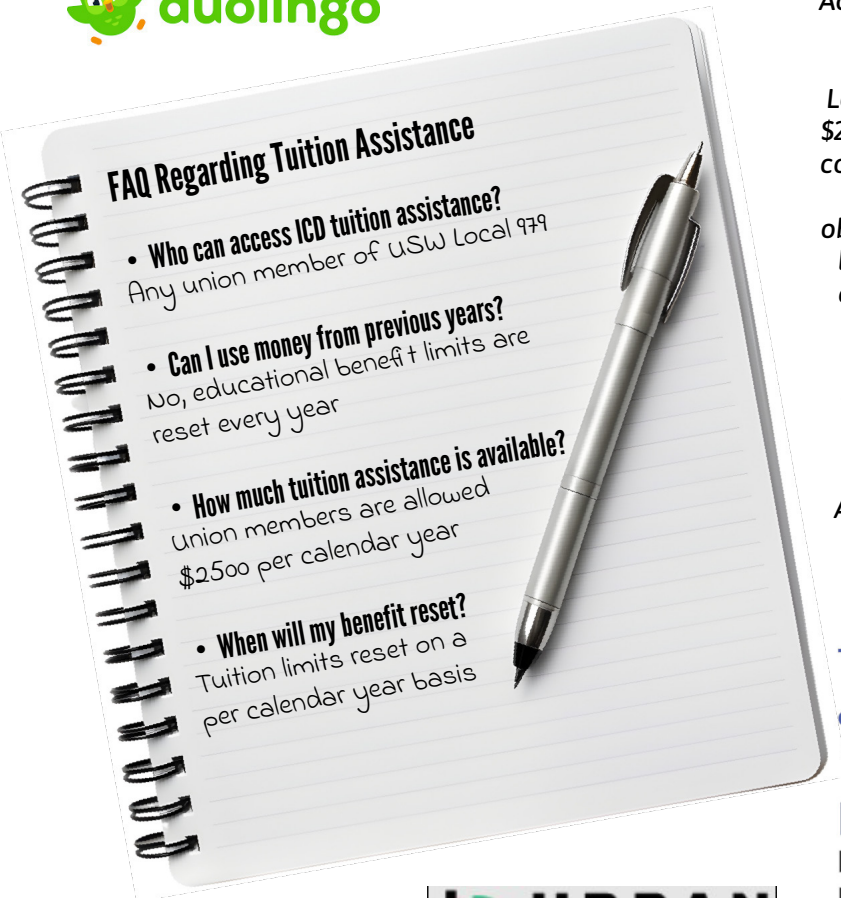
Additional benefits ICD offers to active hourly employees include tuition vouchers and subscription reimbursements.

Local 979 members working at Cleveland Cliffs may utilize up to \$2500 per year in tuition assistance for both credit and non-credit courses. These vouchers can be used for both in-person or on-line learning and are not limited to those seeking degrees, such as obtaining a CDL or a real estate license. In addition, if you have a license or certificate that the State of Ohio requires continuing education to maintain (e.g. real estate, NEC, teaching), ICD can pay for these continuing education classes.

If using Tuition Assistance funds for subscription-based online learning providers, participant is limited to one active subscription at a time and no more than \$500 per year.

Course Options and Tuition: NOTE: Tuition 100% paid by ICD

Online, Classroom and Field Course Premier Package. (Covers all 120 Hours of pre-license education required in Ohio to pursue a license) Tuition is \$2,155 and is paid by ICD Tuition Assistance (NOTE: Students have the option to find local inspector and participate in 10 shadow inspections instead of doing Class and Field training option)

What this course covers: This course teaches individuals how to inspect a residential property and provide a professional inspection report to Real Estate agents and Mortgage professionals. The course covers Structure, Exteriors, Roofing, HVAC, Electrical, Plumbing, Insulation/Ventilation systems, Report Writing, and Business Development/Marketing.

Average inspections pay between \$300 - \$500 and take about 3 hours based on age and square footage of the property. You do not have to be an expert in construction!!

Application Deadline November 10, 2025

Rules for Eligibility

- Must have a 3.0 GPA and must provide a transcript if selected.
- Must be a college student starting or returning to college in the fall of 2025 or spring of 2026 or enrolled in a recognized vocational/training program for the fall semester of 2025 or spring semester of 2026.
